- √ US Citizen
- √ Live in Milwaukee County
- √ 18-24 years old
- √ Aged out/aging out of the Foster Care or Juvenile Justice Systems
- √ Currently unemployed
- √ Meet required family income limit
- ✓ Not currently receiving W-2 benefits, and not eligible to receive Unemployment Insurance Compensation
